

# THE HUMAN WHO DOESN'T HEAR AND SEE

A Disclaimer About the Usage: A dear Christian shares her experiences concerning what Yahweh has done: a removal to hear Yahweh in conversation form. ## THE HUMAN BEGINS TO YIELD HER JOURNAL NOTES

### THE HUMAN:

Once I heard Yahweh, then...nothing.

I remember the first time I heard the voice of the Lord. I was a high school student who had only been a Christian for a short time when, while walking alone in the apartment I resided in, I heard, "I love you." It was like someone was standing behind me and said it in a loud, clear voice. I looked back, but there wasn't anyone there. I was confused but didn't think much of it. Later, after it had happened again, I learned that it was Yahweh speaking to me. I was thrilled! I told a friend about this experience, who was going to a school where they talked about how to walk in the prophet office. As one of her textbooks, she had to read a book she lent me. I recall reading a passage in the book that said something like (paraphrased), 'in order to hear the Lord's voice, focus on something in nature, like a tree or a flower, or listen to soothing music. Clear your mind of distractions. Have a notebook ready to record whatever He says to you.' I followed the instructions, looked out the window, and stared at a tree of cherry blossoms. After a long time of waiting, I heard Yahweh tell me once more that He loved me. I thought, because of this, everyone could do this simple thing to hear the Lord's voice.

# **YAHWEH RESPONDS #1**

## **YAHWEH IS SPEAKING:**

This teaching is for all who want to hear Me give instructions in paragraph ways. Do not empty your mind. Do not stare blankly and meditate. Do not go into automatic writing. The book this person read is an enabler of dabbling in occultic practices. How do I talk with real prophets? I literally say what I want to tell them. There is no need to play soaking music or wait in a prayer closet or focus on an object. The Word of the Lord came to the prophet when Yahweh wanted to say anything. That's how I dealt with a prophet of old. But how do I deal with Christians? Through the Great Holy Spirit, there will be a leading to stay within the boundaries of hearing and seeing in a blanket illumination from the Word of Yahweh, the canon form. This is the normal way to hear Me, not aiming to have conversations with Me through conjuring as if aiming to gain the attention of a lowercase god. I will draw you by My Spirit. 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## **THE HUMAN:**

In my arrogance and ignorance, I began to look down on anyone who questioned hearing Yahweh's voice. Even pastors, who would politely nod but give me a weird, perplexed look when I said that I heard Yahweh say something to me, I'd think, "What's wrong with you? Why aren't you hearing Yahweh?" I didn't know that this was something unusual, that Yahweh allowed me to be privy to something that wasn't attainable for everyone.

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #2**

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

It wasn't a privilege; It was due to work duties. There are no special Christians, but there are special work assignments.

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### **THE HUMAN:**

And yet, instead of praising Him for allowing me to experience this amazing gift and asking Him to show me how I should properly use this, I boasted that Yahweh spoke to me and showed me various things. I became unteachable. Yahweh would try to tell me something, and I'd shrug it off as if I knew better than Yahweh Himself. I'd tell Him things privately, and He'd attempt to tell me how to resolve the situation, but instead of doing as He said, I'd ignore the path He'd give and go my own way. Then I'd blame Him later for the misgivings in my life as if it were His fault. I was wrong. The pride was so strong in my heart that, even when Yahweh said, "You have too much pride. You won't listen. You're unteachable," I scoffed and pouted. Finally, He got to the point where He told me, through His servant, the punishment for my arrogance and, oftentimes, disobedient manner. "You'll become like a regular Christian. You'll have to discover My will just like everyone else." I didn't realize what that meant, but I knew that I wouldn't like it. I felt the result of the punishment almost instantly. It was like a tangible presence left the room. I felt alone, like my best friend was gone. I'd cry, "Where'd You go?!" and I wouldn't get a response back. I'd write down my thoughts, and Yahweh wouldn't speak back.

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #3**

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

Should I respond? If you say something or note what you are thinking, is Yahweh under obligation to hear? Should I follow and talk with you in conversations so you feel like all the attention comes your way? What Yahweh has done was let you drink from a modern-day prophet of old. What her mantle has is not transferrable with the casual laying on of hands. But what I have done was allowed a small drinking of what mantle comes with this level of work. And you only tasted a small percentage, but without prophet training, you did not deal with a root heart victim spirit, and you dealt with the mantle as if it was common and granted just because you say you love God. A transferment on any level comes for the building up of the work Yahweh gives and so souls can hear Yahweh's plan and drink it.

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### **THE HUMAN:**

I would write something down, thinking, "Is this really Him?" But I think that it was me writing down what I thought He'd say in that instance. Like, I'd write down, "Yahweh, I feel so alone," and because I know that He wouldn't leave me or forsake me, I'd write that down in response. But a big part of me knew that He didn't say anything. It was just me writing down Scriptures and what I thought He'd say at that moment.

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #4**

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

See, this is how that Calling book goes. She writes her thoughts down but says that Jesus says them. A false power sharing. If Yahweh is not saying whatever words are spoken, yet you come and say that they are from Yahweh, isn't that now you telling lies? And what will happen to those who are taking in the nature of Satan, the father of lies?

(5) And He who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also He said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true." (6) And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment. (7) The one who conquers will have this heritage, and I will be his God and he will be My son. (8) But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

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### **THE HUMAN:**

I cried and began messaging various friends: "How do you hear the Lord's voice? How do you know that what you are hearing is Him?" A friend who I knew struggled with understanding Yahweh's voice told me that she'd ask God about a path. "Is this the right guy for me? Should I go to this school?" If doors began to open so that she could pursue the guy or go to the school, then she assumed that it was God giving His blessing. But, once, she had asked Yahweh about a certain guy, and at first, things began to line up for

her where it seemed like he was the one. Then one day, things fell apart, and she questioned, "Well, did I really hear the Lord in the first place?" I began to wonder, "Is that the way my life is headed now?" I went to a school where so many students said that they had prayed and asked the Lord, "Which school?" And a flyer would appear in their mailbox for the school we were then attending, and they said, "Ah! The Lord answered my prayer!" I wondered, "How did pastors know that the Lord was calling them to lead the church?" I heard it so often. I questioned a friend who'd recently become a pastor, and he told me that if a thought that he knew wasn't his own came to mind, then he knew it was the Lord. He also said that God would never contradict His Word. I had thought, "That makes sense, but there aren't passages that say, 'thus says the Lord, you shall not go to this kind of school.'"

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #5**

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

I will never contradict My Word, but there must be an understanding that I can overrule what plan was clearly to be revealed. And that means that Yahweh can give one solid plan and then change it based on factors that surround what plan was originally given. What Yahweh does not do is always leave breadcrumbs to know who to date or which school to go to. How about looking at making choices that cater to following Yahweh's Kingdom order? And if it's a guy who is unequally yoked, then that is an automatic 'no.' Doesn't Yahweh's Word state certain parameters on being married and how a believer should not engage in a plan that will lead to being unequally yoked? They say, "don't be unequally yoked by getting married," but wouldn't the use of common sense reveal that it would not be wise to date an unbeliever, hoping to turn them? So, that is the way of staying within Kingdom culture. Stay in environments that do not walk contrary to Yahweh.

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## **THE HUMAN:**

I fell into confusion. I became depressed. I stopped journaling; after all, what was the point? He wasn't going to say anything back anyway. I became a little brat. I didn't pray as often. I questioned everything. How would I know the right path from now on? How would I know that the job I pursued was the right one if I didn't hear Yahweh say audibly to me, "This is it"? How would I know that the man who walks up to me would be the one that I am to marry? Would everything become a guessing game, and I just hoped for the best? Is that how a regular Christian thinks?

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #6**

JANUARY 6, 2023

## **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

A regular Christian would say, "Yahweh, please place heart checks in my spirit. I want to honor You in my decisions I give and make, and I need to see through Your way. Please, grant me wisdom; I ask from You."

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## **THE HUMAN:**

I began attending a church where the pastor and many members would say, "I feel the Lord is saying..." On baptism nights, before a person goes into the water, the pastor would whisper something for that person's ears only. For me, I was told that my story would be told and would change the lives of many. He told me that I would be given a new identity in Christ and that I'd be a witness to others. I really needed to hear that at the time. I needed that reminder that everything was going to be okay for me. Then, one day, the pastor told me I heard Yahweh in ways that were unique. I had thought, "don't you claim to hear Yahweh as well in this way?"

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #7**

JANUARY 6, 2023

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

So, you take it as if you would not mean anything special if you didn't have this prophet trait transferment? You liked having something others noticed that set you apart from all the other Christians. But there must be an understanding: Prophets are the greatest mistreated group in the Body of Christ. And having a taste of hearing and seeing without filters is not given to bring a platform for the servant. The office gifts make room to bring glory and honor to Yahweh. So, your pastor was wrong to lift you up. What he should have said: "Dear daughter in Christ, you can do His will. When God is for you, who can be against you and prevail."

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### **THE HUMAN:**

Often, during worship, someone on the team would say, "I can sense the Lord saying right now to (for example), 'let it go.' And I'm sensing that He means, 'Let go of the things hurting you, that are holding you down and give it to Him.'" Or the pastor would say, "I can sense that the Lord wants someone to give their life to Him today. You've been struggling, running from the Truth, trying to figure out, 'is this really real?' And the Lord is telling you, 'Yes, it is. All you have to do is accept Me.'" Then, there'd be times when a member would say, "I was reading my Bible, and the Lord spoke to me and said, 'This is for you.'"



## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #8**

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

People like to go on their feelings and emotions. And music tends to stir up others and brings them a certain opening that can drink in whatever someone says they “feel” they heard. People should just stay with a statement similar to “When reading my Bible, I thought about you. May I share a Scripture? And you can take it to Yahweh in prayer.” And stop saying they feel led to do anything. And having these ways of common sayings and branding them as from Yahweh will not strengthen the people. Why? Because there is no covenant power backing up hopeful feelings. Have hope but in the Word. Show your faith with works. But do not say your feelings confirm Yahweh is having a conversation.

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### **THE HUMAN:**

I still do not entirely understand how a person hears Yahweh without the gift He bestows. I didn’t realize that it was a gift to hear His voice in the first place. I also didn’t realize that I was drawing from a prophet’s mantle. I thought that this was just something for everyone to experience. I miss hearing Yahweh. I miss the assurance. Part of me feels like I’ve lost my ability to trust.

I ask myself many questions: If I am not hearing Him audibly, how do I trust that I’m being led in the right direction? What would tell me that I’m going the right way? If I follow my friend’s advice, there would be doors that open for me all the time, which seems right, but is it really the right one? What would be the proof that I need to show me that I’m doing the right thing, that I was led in the right direction? As Yahweh continues to strip me from hearing His voice and changing me into a regular Christian, I feel fear and doubt. How does my faith grow stronger when I’m not sure of anything

right now? Am I stepping out of His will with the decisions that I am making? Even now, I'm in a crisis, and I wonder, "Is this correct? Am I going about this the right way?" I can't hear Yahweh. People have told me, "If you feel a peace, then you're on the right track." I've realized that I don't feel peace either way. Some days, I think I should go one way; I try it and don't feel at peace. The next, I try going the opposite way and still don't feel peace.

## **YAHWEH RESPONDS #9**

JANUARY 6, 2023

### **YAHWEH SAYS IT:**

When you put others before yourself, that is a great part of winning the battle. When you are under the fruit of the Great Holy Spirit, your judgment will not cater to the way of what feels better. I grant real wisdom by asking. And if you believe that I kept many Christians from hundreds of years who never had a trait taste and they are in Heaven, why would I not honor My Word with you? That is why the Church is split in decisions and doctrine: no knowledge of the written Word. And where do you stand? Drinking from the myths of famous fake prophets and street ministers, or is your heart pure through coming after Yahweh? Clean hands and a pure heart; that is what I want. There are no special favors for any Christian. And prophets may appear to have all the fancy flavors of fun and being in a plan of hearing and seeing, but at what cost? I do not give a surging of power to honor a person. Only Yahweh must get all glory. And no stripping of your fleshly nature was done; We wanted you to drink from the mantle to learn in tandem, but your way hated others giving you counsel. You said, "If I can hear Yahweh, why do I need anyone else telling me anything?" Pride brought Satan down, and no one will come and have a platform for any purpose and have covenant drinking when they purposely choose not to yield over their pride. How long was the servant giving you these listening plans and drinkings? Over ten years. That is a long time to wait on yourself.
